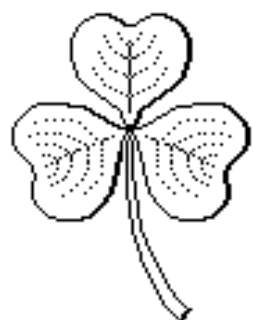

Also, you may drop the sheet off in the drop box at 110 Oak Grove Office. The sheet will be reviewed and investigated by the property manager and she will call you of the outcome.

Community Service Notifications: The notifications have been sent to you by **Sharon Rogers**, Case Manager; if you received a letter please contact her at **929-0229 Ext. 12**, for further instructions. In order to be eligible for continued occupancy, each adult family member must either (1) contribute eight hours per month of community service (not including political activities) in the City of Warner Robins, or (2) participate in an economic self-sufficiency program unless they are exempt from this requirement approved by the WRHA.

Emergency Calls: Refers to a response to conditions that pose an immediate threat to life, facilities, health and safety of residents and agency property. Emergencies include: fire of any nature; gas leaks; broken water supply line(s); electrical fault with visible sparks or overheating; complete loss of electrical power not related or due to electric company; loss of air conditioning in elderly buildings; sewer back up and excess flooding (excluding a toilet running over).

ST. PATRICK'S DAY RECIPE

IRISH POTATO CAKES

1/2 lb. raw potatoes	1/2 tsp. ground black pepper
1/2 lb. potatoes, <u>boiled & mashed</u>	1 sm. onion, finely grated
2 eggs	1/4 c. milk
2 tbsp. flour	1/4 c. butter or cooking oil
1 tsp. salt	

Peel the raw potatoes and coarsely grate them on to a clean cloth. Remove excess moisture from the potatoes. Combined in a large bowl grated & mashed potatoes then mix in eggs with a spoon.

Add the flour, salt, pepper, grated onion and milk to the egg and potato mixture. Stir until all the ingredients are combined.

Heat the butter or cooking oil in a large skillet. Drop 2 or 3 large spoonfuls of the mixture into the pan and cook for 3-4 minutes on each side, or until the potato cakes are golden and crisp round the edges. Cook the remaining potato cakes, adding more butter/grease to the pan if needed.

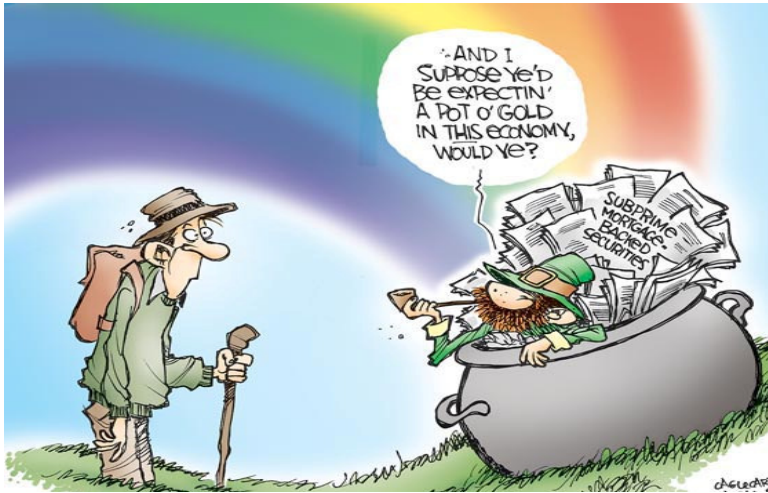

As Case Manager, I am here to serve you! I welcome any suggestions you may have.

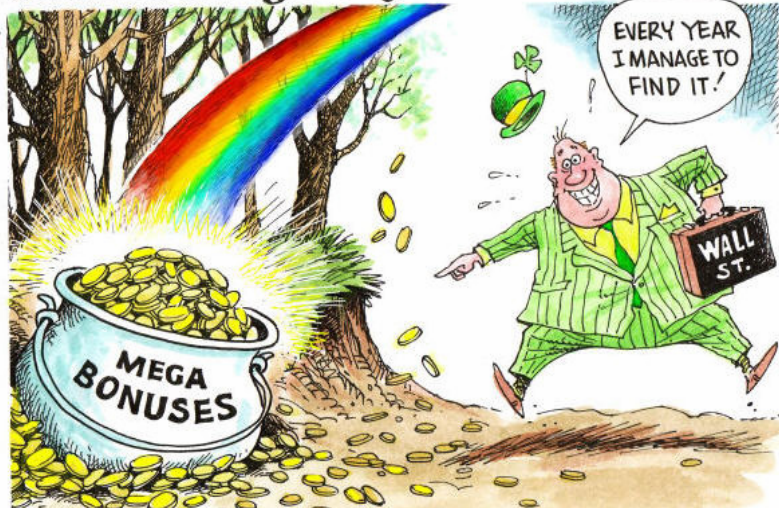
