



## Are you a Senior Citizen aged 62 and older??

Warner Robins Housing Authority offers the **Ross Grant Program** to assist seniors in becoming self-sufficient in their everyday lives.

**The ROSS program aims to:**

- **Enhance quality of life by connecting residents to services and activities**
- **Enable participants to age/remain in place**
- **Avoid more costly forms of care, such as nursing homes or other institutional facilities.**
- **Provide transportation to and from doctor's appointments,**
- **Provide housekeeping assistance, if needed**
- **Wellness classes**
